Sollte die Anzahl der ausgewerteten Fragebögen (N) unter 10 liegen, wurden die offenen Antworten manuell anonymisiert.

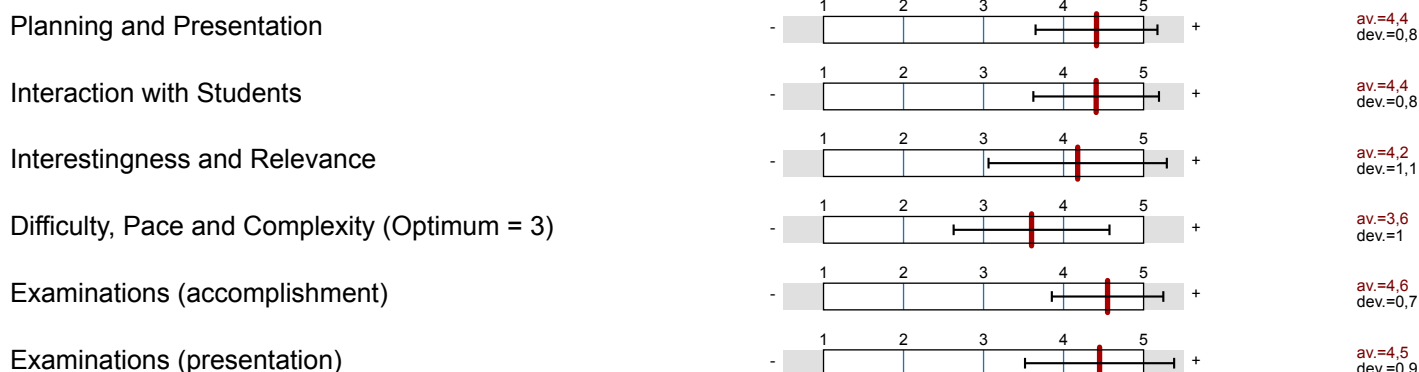
